
# Project Life Cycle

Every project needs a structure. So, it is necessary to follow five crucial phases:

- *INITIATION*: initiation: a phase in which the project's value and workability are measured. The plan proposed is deeply analyzed based on specific requirements;
- *PLANNING*: planning: once the project is approved, it needs a solid plan that will guide the team toward the production of outputs, the creation of acceptance, the communication with stakeholders and suppliers;
- *EXECUTION*: a phase in which the project takes action, allocating resources and delivering the outcome;

# Project Life Cycle

- *MONITORING & CONTROL*: The team must continuously monitor the plan's progress, the KPIs, costs and time;
- *CLOSURE*: It occurs when the project is delivered in full to the customer.



- Define project at a broad level
- Plan project and develop a roadmap
- Put the plan into action and create deliverables
- Monitor and control project progress to avoid overruns
- Close the project and file the report

- > Constructing a building or facility;
- > Designing a new vehicle;
- Acquiring a new or modified data system;
- Implementing a new business process
